

Baggage Allowance and Excess Policy

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this procedure is to advise all ground handling personnel of the Baggage Allowance and Excess Weight Policy taking into account the operational restrictions and commercial considerations.

2. PROCEDURE

The policy consists of the following rules:

2.1 Free Baggage

The baggage allowance for passengers travelling on Tus Airways flights is defined according to the below table. Each individual is entitled **only** the below baggage allowance:

Infants (up to 2 years old) – not occupying a seat	One pushchair and one car seat	One piece up to 8 kilos
Children (from 2 to 12 years old)/ Infants occupying a seat	Same as adult allowance	

DIMENSIONS ALLOWANCES			
Type of Baggage	Height (cm)	Length (cm)	Width (cm) (or depth)
Checked Baggage	90	75	43
Hand Bags	55	45	18
<p>Notes: The dimensions quoted refer to the bag being at an upright position (standing) and include handle, pockets and wheels. The hand bag must be able to either to be fitted into the cabin's overhead lockers and lifted unaided or positioned below the seat.</p>			

2.2 Excess Baggage Charges

For all flights the below Excess Baggage charges shall apply:

EXCESS BAGGAGE CHARGES (per sector)		
Category	Prepaid Baggage Charges (Online via Tus Airways website)	Charges in Airport
Bags (up to 15 kilos)	EUR 20 / USD 30 per piece	EUR 40 / USD 45 per piece


ADDITIONAL WEIGHT (per sector)	
Category	Charges ONLY in Airport
Over 15kgs (up to 30 kilos)	EUR 5 / USD 6 per kilo

2.3 Sporting Equipment (Subject to space available)

Category	All Destinations Charges (per sector at the Airport only)
All sporting equipment (including collapsible bicycles) up to 23kgs and 2.00m length such as water/snow ski, golf, bowling equipment, sporting/hunting guns, fishing, archery etc	EUR 30/ USD 35
Diving equipment (except oxygen bottles) and all other equipment.	EUR 50 / USD 55

Sporting equipment will only be accepted if it is packed properly (so that damage is avoided) and consists of no more than the following items:

- **Sporting/Hunting guns** can be accepted only as checked baggage or cargo provided that are packed in a separate weapons case. The below table charges will apply in each case. Total weight of ammunition for sporting purposes cannot exceed 5 kilos (packaging included) per passenger. Specific standards need to be fulfilled, including packaging in a solid packet (plastic or carton). For more information please contact Tus Airways Call Centre (Tel. - **Golf equipment (maximum dimensions 190cm * 75cm * 65cm)**
 - One bag (containing a maximum of 14 clubs).
 - A dozen balls
 - One pair of golf shoes
 - A large golfing umbrella
- **Bowling equipment:**
 - Bowling ball
 - Bowling shoes
- **Diving equipment:**
 - One empty diving bottle (open and valve removed)
 - One scuba regulator
 - Buoyancy control jacket

- Mask
 - Pressure gauge
 - One set of fins
 - One spear gun (unloaded with spears packed separately)
 - Snorkel
 - Diver's knife
 - Weight belt
- The bottles require a special treatment, therefore all necessary information should be obtained in good time from Tus Airways Call Centre (Tel. No +357 24 200334 & +357 24 200335) or e-mail reservations@tusairways.com
- **Archery equipment:**
- One bow
 - One quiver
 - Arrows
- **Fishing equipment:**
- Two rods
 - One reel
 - One pair of fishing boots
 - One tackle box
 - One landing net
- **Bicycles** should be packed, their handlebars should be fixed sideways, their pedals removed or fixed inwards and their tires should be flat. **(Four bicycles are allowed per sector).**
- **Ski equipment** (must be packed in a separate recognized ski or snowboard bag:
- One pair of skis (or water skis).
 - Ski boots (packed separately with skis)
 - Poles
 - A mask or helmet

Sporting equipment will be charged extra at the Airport prior to departure

Tus Airways reserves the right not to accept the transportation of sporting equipment due to aircraft limitations.

2.4 Musical Instruments (Subject to space available)

One piece of musical instrument may be carried in the cabin (free of charge) in addition to the hand baggage allowance provided that, its weigh is up to the hand baggage allowance, and its dimensions fulfill the specifications below.

Height (cm)	Length (cm)	Width (cm) (or depth)
102	33	26

All musical instruments will be positioned on passenger's feet / space in between the seat rows, for the whole duration of the flight. The Carriage of musical instruments is limited to the following items: a guitar, a violin (or family of stringed instruments) and wind instruments (i.e flutes etc)

A musical instrument may also be carried at an extra seat (max weight 75 kilos and as per above mentioned dimensions) provided that the seat will be reserved and paid (price will exclude passenger surcharges and taxes - no additional baggage allowed for this seat).

Additional piece of musical instrument/s will also be treated as checked baggage and the relevant charges will apply. Musical instruments loaded in the holds should be properly packed in a hard case.

Tus Airways reserves the right not to accept the transportation of musical instruments due to aircraft limitations.

2.5 Pets

Tus Airways accepts certain types of pets and animals (**only dogs and cats**) on its flights provided that they are accompanied by valid health and vaccination certificates, entry permits, and other documents required by countries of entry or transit. Pets in the cabin are allowed, provided that the total gross weight of the pet (i.e. including the container's weight) does not exceed the 9 kilos and the dimensions of the container do not exceed the 48 x 35 x 29cm. PETS transported either in the Cabin or **as checked baggage will be charged as follows:**

Small (up to 8 kilos): In cabin or as checked baggage	EUR 40 / USD 45

With respect to the transportation of your pet always please contact Tus Airways Call Centre (Tel. No +357 24 300 334 & +357 24 200335) or e-mail reservations@tusairways.com for **booking confirmation**.

Carriage of PETS from Unaccompanied minors is not permitted.

Tus Airways reserves the right not to accept the transportation of a pet due to aircraft limitations and cancel the transportation of a pet already confirmed under special circumstances and conditions that might arise at the last minute.

2.6 Items forbidden to be carried

Dangerous Goods, or prohibited items on aircraft, are items that may endanger the safety of an aircraft or persons on board the aircraft.
